Bonding Proposal
<p>Shall Greenville Public Schools, Montcalm, Kent and Ionia Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Forty-Five Million Two Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$45,230,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of:</p> <p>erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to school buildings; remodeling, equipping and re-equipping and furnishing and refurbishing school buildings; acquiring, installing and equipping and re-equipping school buildings for instructional technology; and preparing, developing, improving and equipping athletic facilities, playgrounds and sites?</p> <p>The following is for informational purposes only:</p> <p>The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2023 is 2.12 mills (\$2.12 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a .20 mill net decrease from the prior year's levy. The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty-three (23) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 2.49 mills (\$2.49 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).</p> <p>The school district does not expect to borrow from the State to pay debt service on the bonds. The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$52,660,000. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is \$0. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances.</p> <p>(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Yes</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> No</p>
