CALL TO ELECTION
SPECIAL RECALL ELECTION
MAPLE VALLEY TOWNSHIP, MICHIGAN**

TO ALL REGISTERED VOTERS IN MAPLE VALLEY TOWNSHIP:

You are hereby notified that there were sufficient signatures to proceed with a Special Recall Election against John Schwandt, Maple Valley Township Supervisor. The Special Recall Election is to be held in Maple Valley Township on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, at which time candidates of the Republican and Democratic Parties, and candidates without political party affiliation, who seek election to the partisan office of Maple Valley Township Supervisor are to be voted on in your township.

Pursuant to MCL 168.971c, John Schwandt will automatically appear on the ballot as the Republican Candidate for Maple Valley Township Supervisor, as he was elected to that office at the November 2020 General Election as a Republican. The Montcalm County Democratic Party has the opportunity to nominate a candidate for Maple Valley Township Supervisor by providing that name and an Affidavit of Identity for that candidate to the Montcalm County Clerk no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 6, 2022. Additionally, any No Party Affiliation candidates seeking election to the office of Maple Valley Township Supervisor must file Qualifying Petitions, containing a minimum of 9 and maximum of 30 signatures, and an Affidavit of Identity with the Montcalm County Clerk no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 6, 2022. The candidate receiving the highest number of votes for Maple Valley Township Supervisor at the Special Recall Election to be held on November 8, 2022, will be elected to the remainder of the term pursuant to MCL 168.975.

This notice is provided in compliance with Michigan Election Law, MCL 168.963(2).
