# Glossary

## **AGE**

The age classification is based on the age of the person in completed years as of April 1, 1990. Data on age are used to determine the applicability of other questions for a person and to classify other characteristics in census tabulations. Age data are needed to interpret most social and economic characteristics used to plan and examine many programs and policies.

## **AVERAGE FAMILY SIZE**

A measure obtained by dividing the number of persons in families by the total number of families (or family householders). Another term often used is persons per family.

## **AVERAGE HOUSEHOLD SIZE**

A measure obtained by dividing the number of persons in households by the total number of households (or householders). Another term often used is persons per household.

## **FAMILY HOUSEHOLDS (FAMILIES)**

Consist of a householder and one or more other persons living in the same household who are related to the householder by birth, marriage or adoption. All persons in a household who are related to the householder are regarded as members of his or her family. A household can contain only one family for census purposes. The number of family households always equals the number of families; however, a family household may also include non-relatives living with the family. Families are classified by type as either a "married-couple family" or "other family," which is further classified into "male householder" (a family with a male householder and no wife present) or "female householder" (a family with a female householder and no husband present).

## **GROUP QUARTERS POPULATION**

All people not living in households. The Census Bureau recognizes two general categories of people in group quarters: (1) the institutionalized population, and (2) the noninstitutionalized population. The institutionalized population includes people living in correctional institutions, nursing homes, psychiatric hospitals, juvenile institutions, and other institutions where residents are under supervised care or custody. The noninstitutionalized population includes all people living in college dormitories, group homes, military quarters, shelters and other noninstitutional group quarters.

## **HISPANIC ORIGIN**

Persons of Hispanic origin are those who classified themselves in one of the Hispanic origin categories listed on the questionnaire - "Mexican," "Puerto Rican," or "Cuban" - as well as those who indicated that they were of "other Spanish/Hispanic" origin. Persons of Hispanic origin may be of any race.

## **HOUSEHOLD**

Includes all the persons who occupy a housing unit. Persons not living in households are classified as living in group quarters. The occupants may be a single family, one person living alone, two or more families living together, or any other group of related or unrelated persons who share living arrangements. In sample tabulations, the count of households may differ from the count of occupied housing units as a result of the weighting process.

## **HOUSEHOLDER / REFERENCE PERSON**

One person in each household is designated as the householder. In most cases this is the person, or one of the persons, in whose name the home is owned, being bought, or rented, and who is listed in column one of the questionnaire. Others in the household are identified by their relationship to this reference person.

## **HOUSING UNIT**

Includes a house, an apartment, a mobile home, a group of rooms, or a single room that is occupied (or, if vacant, is intended for occupancy) as separate living quarters. Separate living quarters are those in which the occupants live and eat separately from any other persons in the building, and which have direct access from outside the building or through a common hall.

## **MARRIED-COUPLE HOUSEHOLD**

A household in which the householder and his or her spouse are enumerated as members of the same household.

## **MEDIAN AGE**

This measure represents the middle value in a distribution of ages within the population in a specific geographic area. The median divides the total frequency into two equal parts: one-half of the cases fall below the median and one-half of the cases exceed the median.

## **NONFAMILY HOUSEHOLD**

Includes a householder living alone or with non-relatives only.

## **OCCUPIED HOUSING UNIT**

A housing unit is classified as occupied if it is the usual place of residence of the person or group of persons living in it at the time of enumeration, or if the occupants are only temporarily absent, that is, away on vacation or business.

## **OWN CHILD**

A never-married child under 18 years who is a son or daughter by birth, a stepchild, or an adopted child of the householder. "Related children" in a family include own children and all other persons under 18 years of age in the household, regardless of marital status, who are related to the householder, except the spouse of the householder.



# Glossary

## **(GLOSSARY, continued)**

### **OWNER-OCCUPIED HOUSING UNIT**

A housing unit is owner-occupied if the owner or co-owner lives in the unit, even if it is mortgaged or not fully paid for.

### **RACE**

The concept of race, as used by the Census Bureau, reflects self-identification; it does not denote any clear-cut scientific definition of biological stock. The data for race represent self-classification by people according to the race with which they most closely identify. Furthermore, it is recognized that the categories of the race item include both racial and national origin or socio-cultural groups. The Census Bureau recognizes that there are persons who do not identify with a specific racial group, and thus the 2000 race question included an "Other Race" category with provisions for a write-in entry. For data product purposes, "Some other race" includes race responses not included in the "White," "Black or African American," "American Indian and Alaska Native," "Asian," or "Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander" race categories. Respondents providing write-in entries such as multiracial, mixed, interracial, or a Hispanic/Latino group (for example, Mexican, Puerto Rican, or Cuban) are included in the "Some other race" category.

——Two or more races - "Two or more races" refers to combinations of two or more racial categories selected on the census form. The 2000 Census is the first census that allowed respondents to select more than one racial category.

### **RELATED CHILDREN**

All people in a household under the age of 18 who are related to the householder. Does not include householder's spouse or foster children, regardless of age.

### **RENTER-OCCUPIED HOUSING UNIT**

All occupied housing units which are not owner-occupied, whether they are rented for cash rent or occupied without payment of cash rent, are classified as renter-occupied.

### **SINGLE-PARENT HOUSEHOLD**

A householder with no spouse present, residing with one or more children.

### **VACANT HOUSING UNITS**

A housing unit is vacant if no one is living in it at the time of enumeration, unless its occupants are only temporarily absent. Units temporarily occupied at the time of enumeration entirely by persons who have a usual residence elsewhere are also classified as vacant. When a unit is determined to be vacant, enumerators attempt to ascertain its status and classify it accordingly - for sale, for rent, for seasonal use, etc.
