advised of the new process and advised that this amount decreased to \$348.50 for 2020 and has not been taken out to date. It was also asked why engineering prices dropped from \$2,250 a quarter to \$1,700 and then back up to \$2,000 in 2020.

Weed Control Program

Pam provided an update on the treatment applied on 6/7 for milfoil and curly leaf. A PerCellacore and diquat mixture was used to treat 9 acres of the lake, and the rest was treated with straight diquat. Pam advised that this was a spot treatment, verses a whole lake treatment that the board thought it was going to be. Pam advised that these chemicals are not meant for a whole lake treatment, and only a spot treatment. Flumioxisan was used to treat the North channel.

There being no further business to come before the Lake Board, a motion was made by Michon and seconded by Adam to adjourn the meeting at 5:04 p.m. Motion carried.
