OLD BUSINESS.
Budget

The drain office presented a projected budget for the remainder of the program. This budget showed there will be enough money to fund a Sonar treatment for \$25,000 in 2022. Rick advised of an additional cost for the Sonar treatment in the amount of \$2,500.00 to test the sonar on the lake's aquatic species to make sure the Sonar will be effective on the lake. Plant samples would be collected in summer of 2021 and grown by PLM until the fall for testing. Adam asked what exactly Sonar does, and Rick advised that Sonar is a whole lake treatment that provides longer lasting results that could potentially lower future treatment costs and also inhibits good growth in the lake.

A motion was made by Larry and seconded by Adam to move forward with the Sonar treatment in 2022. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS.

Weed Control Program

Rick treated 1 acre of Starry Stonewort on 7.1.21 by the boat launch. Survey was completed on 7.14.21 and Rick advised that he only found 1 total acre of milfoil and starry stonewort between the channel and the landing combined. He advised that it is not necessary to treat the landing but would be a preventative measure. Rick proposed a cheaper treatment for the remaining milfoil and starry stonewort that would only be around \$100.00 an acre.

There being no further business to come before the Lake Board, a motion was made by Larry and seconded by Adam to adjourn the meeting at 4:38 p.m. Motion carried.
