LAKE IMPROVEMENT BOARD MEETING

May 25, 2022

A meeting of the Townline Lake, Lake Improvement Board was held at the Montcalm County Drain Commission, 211 W. Main Street, Stanton, Michigan on the 25th day of May at 3:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Marv Kladder at 3:00 p.m.

A motion was made by Nancy and seconded by Larry to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Nancy and seconded by Larry to approve the minutes from October 20, 2021, as presented. Motion carried.

Public Comment

Beau asked about the frequency of the Channel Dredging. Todd advised that dredging is done as needed and as financing allows and does not adhere to a regular schedule. Members of the lake have stated that the walleye stocking from last year was successful, and residents have reported catching walleye that are approximately 10" in size. Stephanie asked about if algae sampling was possible to detect blue/green algae. Rick provided contact information for EGLE for if the residents see blue/green algae.

Financial Update

Todd provided a financial update to the board. He stated that 2021 taxes have been collected and added to the ledger to reflect the current balance of \$135,953 for the lake and \$5,141.74 for the channel.

A motion was made by Nancy and seconded by Larry to accept the financial update as presented. Motion carried

Treatment Update

Rick introduced himself to the board and provided a planned treatment map to the board. Nancy asked about treating in front of the old church compound. Rick said that area was cut from the treatment plan because it is undeveloped and the treatment plan will already be over budget due to the large amounts of weeds. He has planned to treat 109 acres. The area in front of the church would add an additional 12 acres. Rick estimated an additional \$5-6K for the 12 additional acres which would bring the treatment total for the season to approximately \$55K.

A motion was made by Nancy and seconded by Larry to expand milfoil treatment to help with boating and skiing on the South and East sides of the island. Motion carried

There being no further business to come before the Lake Board, a motion was made by Marv and seconded by Nancy to adjourn the meeting at 3:50 p.m. Motion carried.

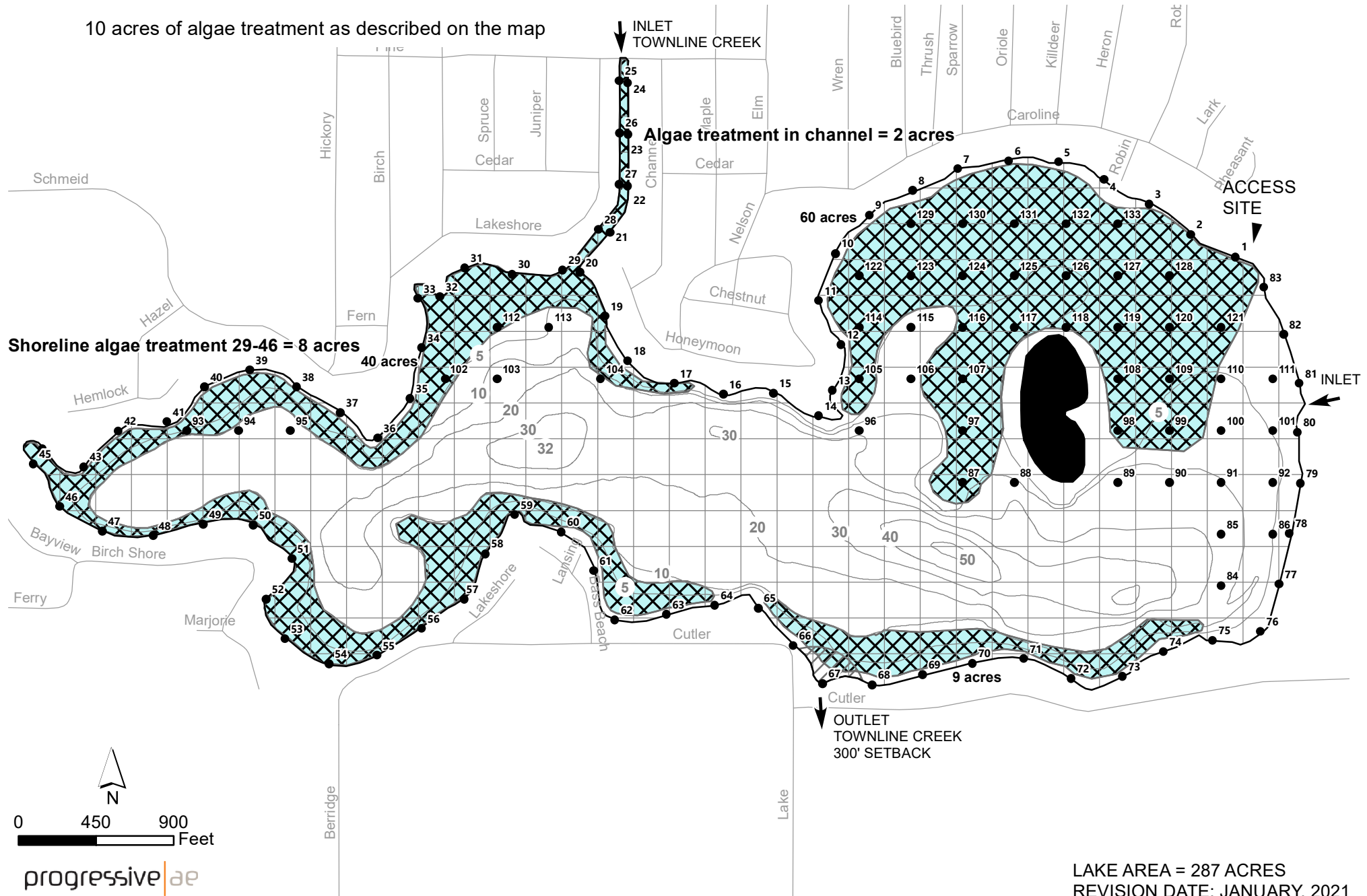
TOWNLINELAKE MONTCALM COUNTY, MICHIGAN MAY 19TH, 2022 TREATMENT MAP
