

TOWNLINE LAKE
LAKE IMPROVEMENT BOARD MEETING
September 16, 2021

A meeting of the Townline Lake, Lake Improvement Board was held at the Montcalm County Drain Commission, 211 W. Main Street, Stanton, Michigan on the 16th day of September 2021 at 3:00 P.M.

Dredge Assessment

Todd Provided an update on the dredge cleanout. He went through the process used for the dredging this year and provided pictures and videos of the work being completed. Todd advised the board to talk to the landowner living next to the channel about the possibility of a grading easement or to work with the road commission to dig a ditch with a yearly cleanout. Todd advised not to spread the taxes for the dredge for next year.

Weed Program Update

Rick provided an update on the weed control program. He advised that the lake was very thick with weeds this season and they had a bit of trouble with control. Milfoil was rampant throughout the lake. Rick believes that it may be beneficial to do some harvesting next season. Todd asked if Perzellacore would be a good fit for the lake. Rick provided information on Perzellacore and advised that he believes it would be best to use with a diquat mixture. This will provide quick results and longer control. Rick stated that many of the plants in Townline didn't respond to the chemicals that were being used this

season. Rick again stated that he believed harvesting was the best option and should cost between \$400-\$500 an acre.

A motion was made by Todd and seconded by Nancy to bid out for harvesting next season. Motion carried

Financial Update

Todd provided a financial update to the board and advised that they are carrying a balance, but they don't want to lower the assessment yet since they are planning on the additional cost for harvesting and additional costs for Percellacore.

2021 Draft Assessment Roll


2021 Draft Assessment Roll was presented to the board for review.
