**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a special assessment roll (including a corresponding computation of costs) has been prepared and is on file for public examination at both offices, the Kent County Drain Commissioner, 775 Ball Ave, NE, Grand Rapids, Michigan, and Montcalm County Drain Commissioner, 211 W Main Street, Stanton, MI 48888 and on either website [https://www.accesskent.com/Departments/DrainCommissioner/meeting\\_notices.htm](https://www.accesskent.com/Departments/DrainCommissioner/meeting_notices.htm) or <https://www.montcalm.us/818/Legal-Lake-Levels>. **TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that the Kent County Drain Commissioner and Montcalm County Drain Commissioner, as the delegated authority of the Lake Level District, will hold a public hearing together for the purposes of reviewing said special assessment roll and project costs and hearing any objections thereto, and/or making a determination of whether to confirm said assessment roll and project costs.

**TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that appearance and protest at the hearing **is required** in order to appeal the amount of the proposed special assessment. Any person or local unit of government objecting to the assessment roll or costs shall: (1) appear at the above stated time and/or file his or her objection in writing with the Kent County Drain Commissioner by no later than the close of the hearing; or (2) file an appearance and protest by letter addressed to the **Kent County Drain Commissioner, on behalf of the Lake Level District, 775 Ball Ave, NE, Grand Rapids, Michigan 49503**, which if received by the Drain Commissioner by no later than the date of hearing, no personal appearance at the hearing is required. The Kent County Drain Commissioner and Montcalm County Drain Commissioner shall maintain a record of parties who appear to protest at the hearing.

Proceedings conducted at this public hearing will be subject to the provisions of the Michigan Open Meetings Act and you are further notified that information regarding this meeting may be obtained from the Drain Commissioner's Office. Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the meeting should contact the Drain Commissioner at (616) 632-7910 or through the Michigan Relay Service at 7- 1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting to request mobility, visual, hearing, or other assistance. Minutes of the meeting will be on file in the Drain Commissioner's Office.

The special assessment roll shall be final and conclusive unless appealed in a court within fifteen (15) days after approval of the special assessment roll by resolution of the Kent County Board of Commissioners and Montcalm County Board of Commissioners. Please review MCL 324.30714(4) for information related to lake level assessment appeals.
