All candidates for County Commissioner must use the “City/Township Nominating Petition” if running as a partisan candidate or the “City/Township Qualifying Petition” if running as a no party affiliation candidate. A different petition form must be used for every city or township signatures are obtained in. In lieu of petitions, candidates may file a \$100 non-refundable filing fee.

County Commissioner will become a 4-year term beginning with the 2025 term, so the term will expire 12/31/2028.

The filing deadline is April 23, 2024, at 4:00 p.m. with the Montcalm County Clerk, located at 639 N. State Street, Stanton, MI 48888.

The Primary Election will be held on August 6, 2024.

The General Election will be held on November 5, 2024.
