Our mission is to provide senior citizens and their families with the necessary assistance and information to maintain health, dignity, independence, and well-being for all residents of Montcalm County who are 60 years of age and older.

Eligible Individuals - 60 years of age and older.

Cost—No set charge for most services, but client services are assisted by donations and cost share.

Supportive Services:

Congregate Meals: Please see our Newspaper, Facebook, or Website for meal site locations and schedules.

Home Delivered Meals/Meals on Wheels: We deliver meals two days per week, providing up to seven meals per week.

Transportation: We provide door to door services, provided by volunteer drivers. If possible, we request at least (3) working days prior to the appointment. We are available for transport both within the county and to appointments outside of the county, as our driver schedules permit.

(Medical appointments, dental appointments, grocery shopping, errands, and Senior Centers for activities and meals).

MMAP— Michigan Medicare/Medicaid Assistance Program. If you have questions or need assistance, please call (989) 831-7476.

Homemaker Services-Light housekeeping, i.e. vacuuming, mopping, clean bathroom, dusting. 1.5 hours every other week.

Personal Care Services: Assisting with bathing, showers, bed baths, etc. 1-2 hours weekly.

Caregiver Respite Services: Respite for the caregiver, keeping loved ones engaged in activities, providing supervision, care & assistance. Up to 8 hours weekly.

Friendly Visitor: Volunteers visit with seniors in their homes.

Volunteer Opportunities:

Drivers-volunteers drive seniors to their medical and dental appointments, grocery shopping, errands, Senior Center for activities and meals, and deliver Meals on Wheels.

Senior Centers: volunteers have a variety of things they can do to help within the Senior Centers. Volunteers can assist with activities, decorating, or assist with on-site meals.

Office: volunteers perform various office duties. They can help with surveys, mailings, donations, phone calls, organizing, shredding, copying and more.

Yarn Stitching: volunteers can help make items such as walker/wheelchair bags, baby blankets/items for the local baby pantries, and lap robes. All items are donated throughout the county.

Friendly Visitor: volunteers visit seniors in their homes. Volunteers are matched according to interests and location.

Caregiver Support Group: All caregivers welcome. Please see our Newspaper, Facebook, or website for our activity schedule and location of groups.
