

What is my time commitment?

Each volunteer position varies according to the assignment and your interest and availability. Check with the Volunteer Coordinator for more specifics.

Can I volunteer by myself or can I work as a group?

Typically, an individual will volunteer individually, but friends, spouses, & family members can team together. A group of individuals may take on a volunteer opportunity and share time and responsibilities.

What happens if I'm on vacation or need to be off?

Simply let your immediate supervisor know as far in advance as possible that you are going to be unavailable.

Is mileage reimbursed?

Yes. If you are a volunteer driver or a friendly visitor, your mileage is reimbursed at the IRS reimbursement rate.

What can Volunteers do to help?

Volunteer Driver

Volunteers drive seniors to their medical and dental appointments, grocery shopping, errands, Senior Centers for activities and meals, and deliver Meals on Wheels, using their own vehicles and receiving mileage reimbursement, or using our vehicles.



Friendly Visitor

Volunteers visit seniors in their homes. Volunteers are matched according to interests and location.

Senior Center Volunteer

Volunteers have a variety of things they can do to help within the senior centers. Volunteers can assist with activities, decorating or assist with on-site meals.



Office Volunteer

Volunteers perform various office duties. They can help us with surveys, mailings, donations, filing, phone calls, organizing, shredding, copying and more.
