

KRAMPE PARK RULES

Pursuant to your request to rent the pavilion at Montcalm County Krampe Park, the attached reservation form **MUST** be signed and returned to the Office of the County Controller within ten (10) working days of being reserved in your name.

1. Reservations for the park pavilion are taken beginning March 15 by calling 989-831-3599. The signed reservation is to be sent along with your rental fee within ten (10) working days of making your reservation to secure your reservation.
2. **All cancellations must be made, in writing, thirty (30) days prior to the reservation date. There will be no refunds for cancellations which are made less than the thirty (30) days before the reservation date.**
3. Krampe Park is open daily from sunrise to sundown from May 1st to October 31st. (Closing date is tentative due to the weather and fall clean-up.)
4. Motor vehicles must be operated at no more than 15 MPH and only on road surfaces and parked only in designated areas. All terrain or recreational vehicles are **not** to be operated on Park property except where specifically designated.
5. Fires are allowed only in designated locations, but **not** when burning bans are issued.
6. All pets or domestic animals **must** be kept on a leash and droppings **must** be picked up.
7. Alcohol - Personal displays of the effects of alcohol or other mind altering substances on Park property is unlawful and prohibited. This is not to be construed as a restriction on authorized park users from privately and peacefully consuming their own alcohol in moderation & in accordance with the County ordinance and state law.
8. Loud, disturbing, or annoying noise or music is prohibited; **camping is not allowed.**
9. Fire arms are prohibited on Park property with the exception of those with proper licensure.
10. Destruction or disruption of wild life or plant life is prohibited.
11. All refuse is to be placed in refuse containers prior to leaving; no household refuse allowed.
12. The pavilion offers electric at the north end of the pavilion with ground-fault circuit interrupter (GFCI) protectors; should any receptacle not work, push in the nearest reset button. If this does not restore power, go to the electric panel and access the key to the panel to reset the breaker.
13. The large pavilion lights will only operate at dark; turn off switches near the electric panel when leaving.
14. Please bring a copy of the rules with you in case of emergency or disagreement over paid reservations.
15. **Weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., call or text 989-818-2047. Weekends and evenings call 989-831-5253 (Central Dispatch) and ask to have the Maintenance Director return a call.**
